(We can customize for you as well, just let us know!!!)
$\square$ A) Produce - $\$ 440.00 / 22$ pickups (only $\$ 20 / \mathrm{wk}$ ). Starting June 5, 2024 This share will consist of 4 or more seasonally available produce items, like radishes, onions, lettuce, green beans, tomatoes, cucumbers, peppers, okra, squash, zucchini, sweet corn, etc. each week. Great for a couple people... larger families might consider selecting an additional share to double the amount of product each pickup.
$\square$ B) Chicken \& Eggs - $\$ 715.50 / 27$ pickups. A whole or cut up chicken averaging 4 pounds and a dozen eggs.
$\square$ C) Beef \& Eggs - \$607.50/27 pickups. Two (2) pounds of ground sirloin and a dozen eggs for 26 pickups.
$\square$ D) Chicken, Beef \& Eggs - $\$ 1,147.50 / 27$ pickups. A whole or cut up chicken averaging 4 pounds and 2 pounds of ground sirloin and a dozen eggs for 27 pickups.
$\square$ E) Everything Package...Produce, Chicken, Beef \& Eggs - $\$ 1,500.00$ that's a SAVINGS OF \$87.50!!!!
$\square$ F) Steak \& Eggs - $\$ 769.50 / 27$ pickups. A pound of our grass-fed steaks, we will rotate your selection of Ribeye, Fillet, New York Strip and Sirloin steaks each pickup along with a dozen eggs for 27 pickups.
G) Surf and Turf - $\$ 1,134.00 / 27$ pickups. A pound of our fresh from Florida shrimp from our previous seafood run and a pound of our grass-fed steaks. We will rotate your selection of Ribeye, Fillet, New York Strip and Sirloin steaks.
